

# Change Cache Size

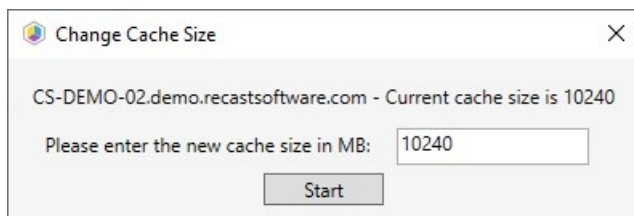
The **Change Cache Size** tool allows a console user to view the current cache size and to enter a new one. This tool can be run on single devices, multi-selected devices, or with a [similar tool designed to be run on a device collection](#).

To run this tool:

1. In your Configuration Manager console, right-click on a device.
2. Click **Right Click Tools** > **Client Tools** > **Client Information**.

**NOTE:** In v4.x, this tool is found under **Right Click Tools** > **Client Tools** > **Change Cache Size**.

3. On the **Cache** tab, click **Change Cache Size**.
4. In the window that opens, enter the new cache size.



5. Click **Start** and confirm the change.

## Microsoft Permissions
