

Uninstall SCCM Client

The **Uninstall SCCM Client** tool removes the Configuration Manager Client on a remote device.

This tool can be run on single or multi-selected devices, or with a [similar tool designed for device collections](#).

To run this tool:

1. In your Configuration Manager console, right-click on a device.
2. Click **Right Click Tools > Client Tools > Uninstall SCCM Client**.
3. Confirm that you want to uninstall the client.

NOTE: The tool does not currently monitor the status or success of the uninstall once begun.

Recast Permissions

- Requires the Uninstall Client permission in the Configuration Manager Client Plugin.

Microsoft Permissions

- Requires administrator permission on the remote device.
- If using a Recast Management Server with a proxy, the service account needs administrator permission on the remote device.
- This tool requires Remote WMI access.
