



Delete Device(s) from ConfigMgr

The **Delete Device(s) from ConfigMgr** tool wipes the history of the device from Configuration Manager by deleting the device from the ConfigMgr database. This tool can be run on single devices and multi-selected devices.

This tool does not uninstall the ConfigMgr Client.

To run the tool:

1. In your Configuration Manager console, right-click on a device.
2. Click **Right Click Tools > Console Tools > Delete Device(s) from ConfigMgr**.
3. Confirm that you want to delete the device.

- The user running the tools will need the Delete Resource permission in ConfigMgr.
- If the using Recast Management Server with a service account, the service account will need the Delete Resource permission in ConfigMgr.
