

# Restart System(s)

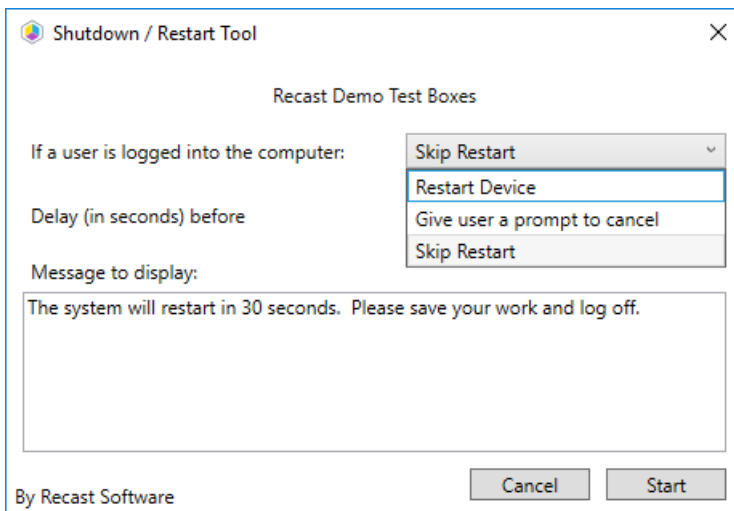

The **Restart System(s)** tool initiates a restart of a device.

This tool can be run on single and multi-selected devices. A similar tool [runs this action on a device collection](#).

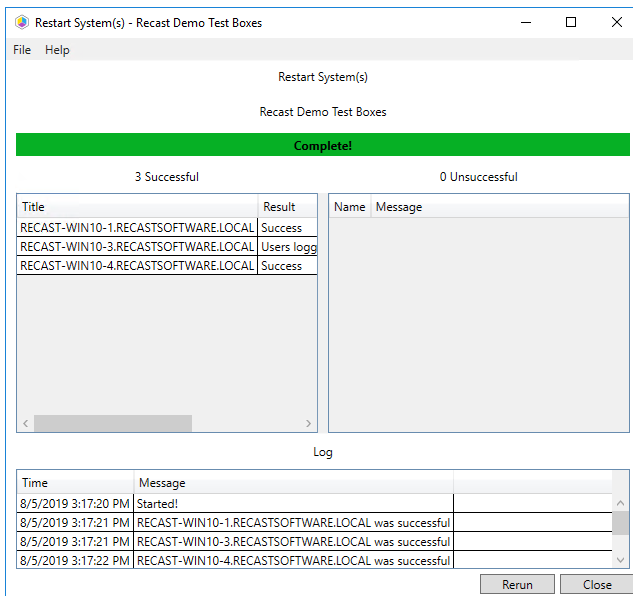
To run the tool:

1. In your Configuration Manager console, right-click on a device.
2. Click **Right Click Tools > Console Tools > Restart System(s)**.
3. In the **Shutdown / Restart Tool** window, choose to **Restart Device**, **Give user a prompt to cancel**, or **Skip Restart** when a user is logged in while attempting the restart action.
4. Set a **Delay (in seconds) before** restart.
5. Customize the **Message to display** prior to restart (optional).



6. Click **Start** to initiate the restart sequence.

The window that opens shows progress and completion according to success or failure.
