2. In the **Create New Connection** window, select a connection **Type**: ActiveDirectory, MEMCM, MBAM, AzureActiveDirectory (Entra ID).

3. Name the new connection and add details associated with the connection type.

Service Connection Type	Required Details
ActiveDirectory	Domain
MEMCM (Configuration Manager)	SMS Provider, Site Code, Database Server, Database
MBAM	Admin URI, Database Server, Compliance Status Database, Recovery and Hardware Database
AzureActiveDirectory (Entra ID)	Name, Tenant ID, Client ID, Client Secret

4. Select a **Proxy Computer Name** and **Proxy User Name** from the drop-down lists.
5. Click the **Confirmed** check box to ensure that the service connection is available for use.
6. Click **Submit**.
