



# Test an Integration

On the Patching **Settings** page, you can test whether a Configuration Manager or Intune integration is set up to function correctly.

The test checks the following:

- [Service connections](#) are working properly
- UNC path is accessible
- Required [proxy permissions](#) are in place

To test an integration:

1. On the **Settings** page, under **Actions**, click the ellipsis (...) to open the drop-down menu.
2. Click **Test Integration**.
