


Delete an Integration

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Deleting an integration removes all configuration associated with the integration, as well as any deployment processes that are only linked to the environment(s) within that integration. This action cannot be undone.

To delete an integration:

1. On the **Settings** page, under **Actions**, click the ellipsis (...) to open the drop-down menu.
2. Click **Delete Integration** and confirm the deletion.
