

## Install Right Click Tools for Intune Browser Extension

Requirements and recommendations for installing and running the Enterprise Edition of Right Click Tools using the Right Click Tools Browser Extension:

- Version 5.10.2506 or later of the [Right Click Tools Enterprise Edition installed](#) on the device from which you will run Right Click Tools actions (required).
  - You can run single device actions using v5.8.2501 or later but [multi-device actions](#) require a minimum of v5.10.2506.
  - If you are installing Right Click Tools on a device where no Microsoft Configuration Manager console is present, you'll need to provide ConfigMgr site information during or after installation.
- Version 5.10.2506 or later of [Recast Management Server installed](#) (recommended)
  - Right Click Tools connected to Recast Management Server (recommended)
  - [Recast Agent installed](#) on the device where you want to run actions, with that device connected to the Recast Management Server (recommended)
- [Right Click Tools browser extension added](#) (required)
  - [Right Click Tools for Intune in Edge Add-ons Store](#)
  - [Right Click Tools for Intune in Chrome Web Store](#)

## Browser Extension Permissions

The Right Click Tools for Intune browser extension requires the following permissions:

`webRequest` – Allows the browser extension to listen for Microsoft Graph API and Recast Management Server device requests. Those devices are then used to enable [multi-device actions](#).

`<all_urls>` – The browser requires a list of all the URLs with which Right Click Tools intends to interact. That list is comprised only of Intune pages and the RMS URL you've specified in your browser extension settings. But because the RMS URLs are specific to each customer, it's necessary to request broad access using the `<all_urls>` permission.

## Browser Extension Installation Workflow

The Right Click Tools browser extension works with both the Enterprise and Community Editions of Right Click Tools. This installation workflow is intended to guide Enterprise customers adding browser extension functionality to an existing implementation of Right Click Tools with Recast Management Server or Right Click Tools Standalone.

Recommended workflow for installing the browser extension with Right Click Tools Enterprise:

1. Make sure that the browser extension [requirements/recommendations](#) are in place.
2. Download v5.8.2501 or later of the Right Click Tools Enterprise Edition from the [Recast Customer Portal](#).

3. Update Right Click Tools and your Recast components to v5.8.2501 or later
4. Add updated Recast licenses to your Recast Management Server or to the Configure Recast Console Extension application.
5. Add the Right Click Tools browser extension

Once you've completed the installation steps, you'll be able to find your familiar Right Click Tools within Intune

## Browser Extension Licensing


A Right Click Tools browser extension license is included in v5.8.2501 and later of the Right Click Tools Enterprise Edition. Right Click Tools Enterprise Legacy licenses include the browser extension functionality in the Right Click Tools Community Edition.

### Enterprise Customers Running Right Click Tools with Recast Management Server

To update your current Recast licensing with a Right Click Tools browser extension license:

1. Log into the [Recast Customer Portal](#) with your Recast Software credentials.
2. Download the Right Click Tools Enterprise Edition and the .zip file containing your Recast licenses.
3. After upgrading Right Click Tools and your Recast components to v5.8.2501 or later, navigate to your Recast Management Server **Licenses** page and click **Upload** to select the licenses you downloaded previously from the portal.

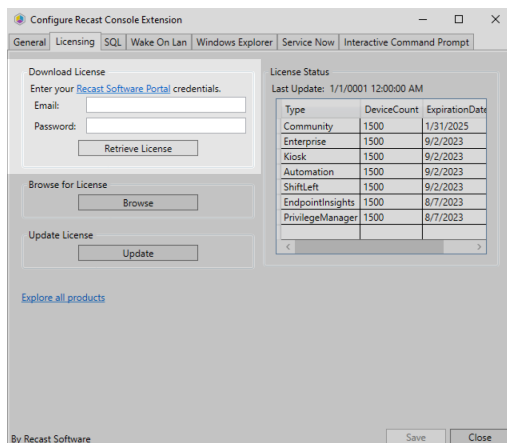
4. Manually add the browser extension license file to the RMS license folder located at `C:\ProgramData\Recast Software\Licenses` .

### Enterprise Customers Running Right Click Tools Standalone

To update your current Recast licensing with a Right Click Tools browser extension license:

# Recast

1. Log into the [Recast Customer Portal](#) with your Recast Software credentials.
2. Download the Right Click Tools Enterprise Edition. At the same time, you can also download the .zip file containing your Recast licenses.
3. After running the Right Click Tools installer, open the Configure Recast Console Extension application from the Window Start menu.
4. On the **Licensing** tab, in the Download License section, enter your Recast Software Portal credentials and click **Retrieve License**.



**TIP:** If you previously downloaded your license from the [Recast Customer Portal](#), you can alternatively locate it using the **Browse** function.

5. If any Configuration Manager console is open during license retrieval, restart the console.

## Add Right Click Tools Browser Extension

You can add the Recast Right Click Tools for Intune browser extension from the Microsoft Edge Add-ons store and the Google Chrome web store.

With the browser extension added, you can then find [Right Click Tools](#) within Intune.

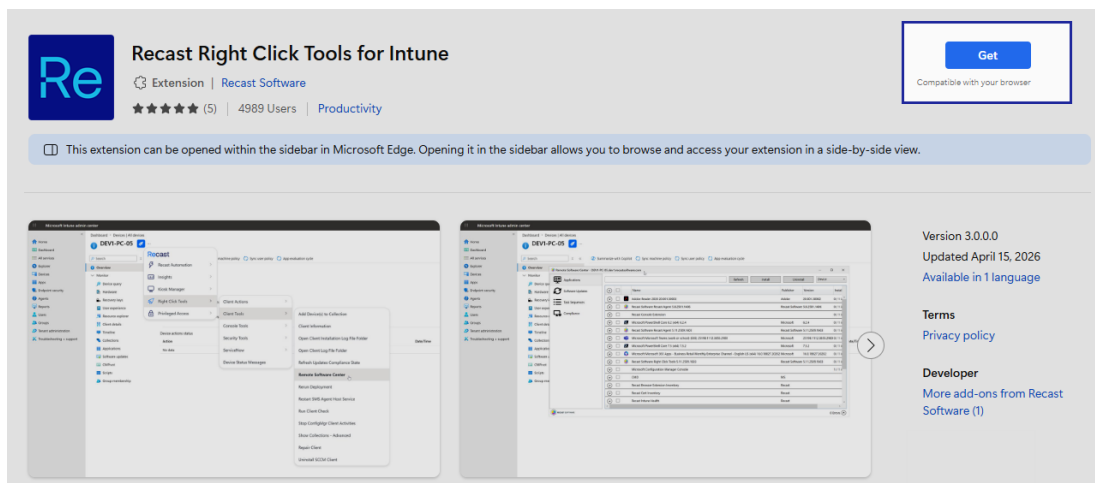
**NOTE:** In organizations that restrict browser extension access, add Recast Right Click Tools for Intune to the list of allowed browser extensions.

### Microsoft Edge Browser Extension

To add the Edge browser extension:

1. In the Microsoft Edge Add-ons store, navigate to [Recast Right Click Tools for Intune](#).
2. Click the **Get** button.

3. Confirm that you want to add Recast Right Click Tools for Intune by clicking **Add extension**.

4. Make the extension visible in your browser toolbar by clicking the Extensions icon (the puzzle piece) located in your toolbar.



5. In the drop-down menu that opens, click the Pin icon to the right of Recast Right Click Tools for Intune.



## Google Chrome Browser Extension

To add the Chrome browser extension:

1. In the Google Chrome web store, navigate to [Recast Right Click Tools for Intune](#).

2. Click **Add to Chrome**.

3. Confirm that you want to add Recast Right Click Tools for Intune by clicking **Add extension**.

4. Make the extension visible in your browser toolbar by clicking the Extensions icon (the puzzle piece) located in your toolbar.



5. In the drop-down menu that opens, click the Pin icon to the right of Recast Right Click Tools for Intune.



## Connect Browser Extension to Recast Management Server

Make the most of the Right Click Tools for Intune browser extension by connecting it to your Recast Management Server.

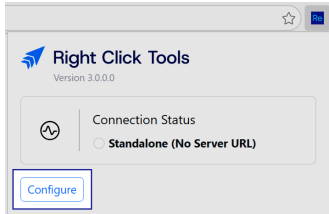
# Recast

To connect the browser extension to RMS:

1. In your browser toolbar, click the Recast icon.



2. Click **Configure**.



3. On the **Right Click Tools Configuration** page that opens, enter the **Server URL**, including `https://` at the beginning. Click **Save**.

The **Connection Status** should show as 'Connected'.
