

## Exclude Dependencies

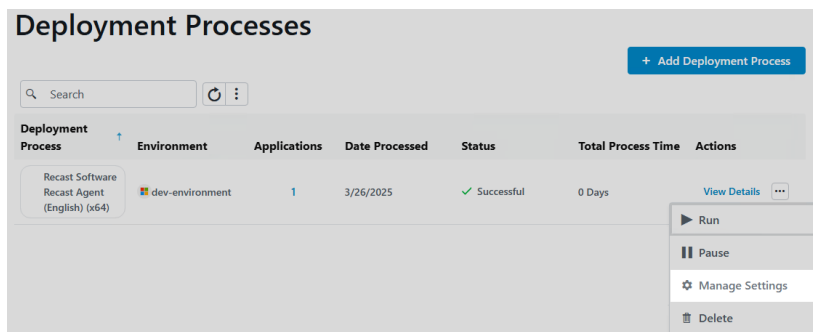
By default, applications indicated as dependencies are automatically added to deployment processes. You also have the option to prevent dependencies from being added, which may be helpful if a specific dependency is known to cause issues when updating applications with RCT Patching. **NOTE:** Make sure you manage any excluded dependencies manually to ensure that applications continue to work correctly.

To exclude dependencies from one or all deployment processes:

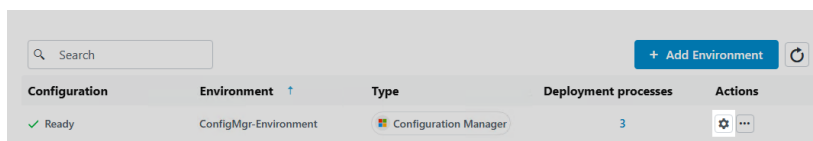
1. Navigate to the **Dependencies** section in your deployment process settings or global settings, depending on whether you are excluding dependencies from one deployment process or all deployment processes.

Single deployment process: From the **Deployment Processes** page, click the ellipsis (...) to the right of the deployment process and select **Manage Settings**. In the Deployment process settings side panel, open the **Advanced** tab.



**TIP:** You can run install actions for an individual application by creating a deployment process that includes only that one application.

All deployment processes: From the **Settings** page, click the Settings cog to the right of the environment. On the **Environment Settings** page, click **Deployment Processes > Advanced**.



2. In the Dependencies section, toggle the **Exclude Dependencies** setting to 'Yes'.
3. Click **Save & Close**.
