

Connect printer

The *Connect printer* action allows you to connect a printer to devices, as part of the package actions. This could be used to connect to a certain printer which is only used by a specific package.

General

Type *Connect printer*

Name Actions are easier to comprehend and manage over time when they have a suitable name that accurately expresses what they do.

The type of printer you want to add:

Printer type

- *Windows network printer*
- *Internet Printing Protocol (IPP)*

The network path (UNC) for a Windows network printer or the URL of an IPP printer. For example:

– \server\printerName

– https://printserver/printerQueue

Address Supported IPP protocols:

– ipp (same as http)

– ippes (same as https)

– http

– https

Printer name Only for IPP printers: the name of the printer.

Description Only for IPP printers: the description of the printer.

Location Only for IPP printers: the location of the printer.

Default Determines whether the printer will be added as the new default printer.

Advanced

Context The level at which the action is executed, *User* or *Device*.

Network Credentials The network credentials from the credential store, which will be used to access the specified printer. The

option is available only for Windows.

Filters
