The *Set default printer* action allows you to set a printer as default on devices. This action does not connect devices to a new printer; you should use the [Connect printer](#) action to do this.

General

Type *Set default printer*

Name Actions are easier to comprehend and manage over time when they have a suitable name that accurately expresses what they do.

The network path (UNC) for a Windows network printer or the URL of an IPP printer. For example:

- \\server\printerName
- https://printserver/printerQueue

Printer Supported IPP protocols:

- ipp (same as http)
- ippes (same as https)
- http
- https

Advanced

Context The level at which the action is executed, *User* or *Device*.
