

Registry value

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Use *Registry value* to filter based on the value of a certain registry entry.

General	
Type	Registry value
Key	For example <code>HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft</code>
Name	The value name of the string
Compare	Equal, Not equal, Contains, Doesn't contain, Starts with, Ends with, Greater than, Less than
Value	The value data of the string
Advanced	
Context	The level at which the action is executed, <i>User</i> or <i>Device</i>
Type	The type of data being stored in a registry value. When <i>Binary</i> is selected as type, the string in the General tab, Value field, must contain a hexadecimal representation of the value and must be space-separated. So <code>Liquit</code> as binary should be typed as <code>4C 69 71 75 69 74</code> .
Use 32bit registry key on 62 bit systems	If selected, Application Workspace first checks 32-bit registry locations for the specified registry key. If the registry key isn't found, it searches 64-bit locations.
