

Registry value exists

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Use *Registry value exists* to filter based on the existence (or absence) of a registry key value on devices.

General	
Type	Registry value exists
Name	The value data of the string
Exists	Yes, No
Advanced	
Context	The level at which the action is executed, <i>User</i> or <i>Device</i>
Type	The type of data being stored in a registry value. When <i>Binary</i> is selected as type, the string in the General tab, Value field, must contain a hexadecimal representation of the value and must be space-separated. So <code>Liquit</code> as binary should be typed as <code>4C 69 71 75 69 74</code> .
Use 32bit registry key on 62 bit systems	If selected, Application Workspace first checks 32-bit registry locations for the specified registry key. If the registry key isn't found, it searches 64-bit locations.
