Use *Registry value* to filter based on the value of a certain registry entry.

General

Type *Registry value*

Key For example `HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft`

Name The value name of the string

Compare *Equal, Not equal, Contains, Doesn't contain, Starts with, Ends with, Greater than, Less than*

Value The value data of the string

Advanced

Context The level at which the action is executed, *User* or *Device*

Type The type of data being stored in a registry value. When *Binary* is selected as type, the string in the **General** tab, **Value** field, must contain a hexadecimal representation of the value and must be space-separated. So `Liquit` as binary should be typed as `4C 69 71 75 69 74`.

Use 32bit registry key on 62 bit systems If selected, Application Workspace first checks 32-bit registry locations for the specified registry key. If the registry key isn't found, it searches 64-bit locations.
