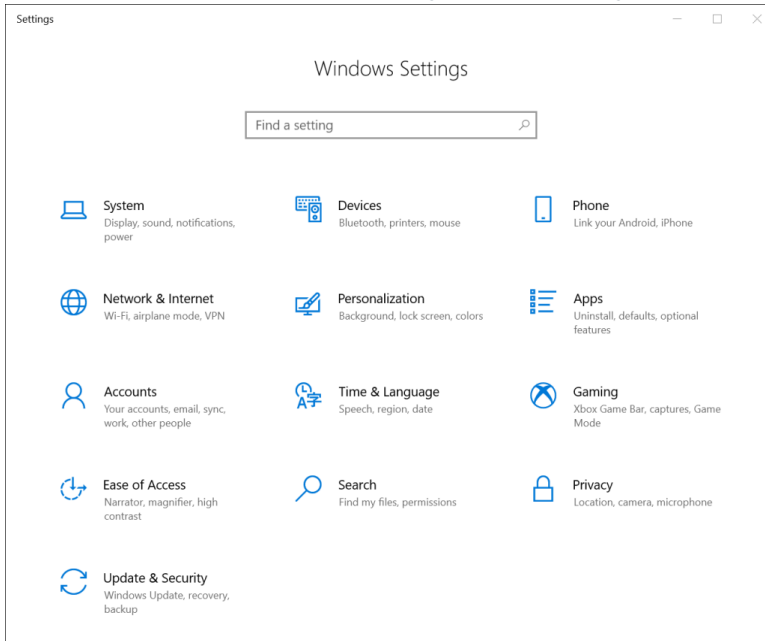


## Launch Windows Settings from Application Workspace
