

ESET Management Agent

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To silently install the ESET Management Agent you need to provide several configuration options. These are included in the Setup Store Wizard for this MSI, and explained in "[Agent installation – Windows](#)" KB article on the ESET support website.

For ERA Agent, insert the Peer certificate (.pfx) signed by your Certification Authority stored in ERA Servers database. Insert the Public key of the Certification Authority (.cer file) which was used to sign your ERA Server Peer certificate.

You can insert the contents of the certificate and public key encoded in Base64 format (no certificate files will be needed).

In ERA Web Console, navigate to Admin > Certificates > Peer Certificate, click Agent Certificate and choose icon_export Export as Base64. Navigate to Admin > Certificates > Certification Authorities, click ERA Certification Authority and choose icon_export Export Public Key as Base64. Add the contents of the exported certificate and public key into the following fields.

Peer certificate in Base64 format

Password for the peer certificate (don't add this when password is empty)

Exported public key of the Certification Authority in Base64 format

Password for the Certificate Authority (don't add this when password is empty)
