When uploading files to ZCM's Content Repository, Bundle Commander automatically uploads files to

```
..\Program Files (x86)\Novell\ZENworks\work\collection\datamodel (Windows)
```

```
./var/opt/novell/zenworks/collection/datamodel (Linux)
```

By using a web service call, the ZCM services will import the uploaded file(s) into the content repository.

```
./log/zenworks/services-messages.log
```

 contains more information about this process.

When you delete a Bundle, its content will be deleted at night, when it's no longer used by a 'Quicktask'. On a primary server, when using the command:

```
zman ql -t=content.cleanup
```

You will get a list of scheduled content.cleanup quick tasks
